To safely navigate the ever-changing waters of 21st century education, teachers and experts across academic disciplines face an acute need to develop and implement innovative pedagogies and technologies which would allow them to anchor the existing practices and routines in modern pedagogical terrain. This call is particularly relevant to higher education, where innovative approaches seem to offer the only viable response to the challenges introduced by diverse and often conflicting phenomena such as linguistic and extra-linguistic communication barriers, digital literacy, cultural diversities, globalisation and glocalisation, and identity conflicts which compound the lack of skills to interact successfully.

Following up on the successful ICCAGE 2017 international conference held in Prague, ICCAGE 2019 aims to bring together educators and experts in the fields of language teaching/learning, personal development, and soft skills training to discuss both new and traditional approaches to global education, share experience, and set the future trends in higher education. Possible topics include, but are not limited to:

- technologies/pedagogies for global students
- perspectives on learner autonomy
- pedagogies of interdisciplinarity
- educating future leaders: pedagogies of (global) employability
- intercultural communicative competence
- teaching in/through 21st century skills
- business English and English for special purposes
- critical and creative thinking and metacognitive skills
